The Hope Foundation (HOPE) is a registered charity working with street-connected children in Kolkata, India. HOPE was set up in 1999 in Ireland, to help restore basic human rights to the street-connected children in Kolkata. Today, HOPE is one of the largest and most recognised NGOs in Kolkata. Since 2007, HOPE has been a branch charity in the UK. The focus in the UK is on raising awareness and raising funds for the projects in Kolkata.
