Hackney Cross Country Championship – report by Ms. Wilburn, Head of P.E.

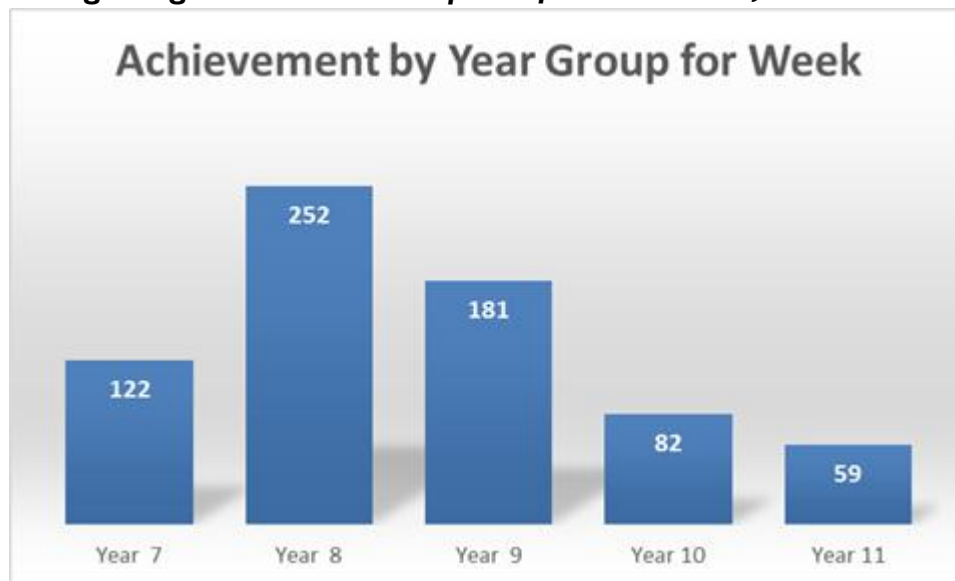
