ADMISSION TO THE SIXTH FORM

Our Lady's High School has 150 sixth form places in total, 75 in each year. Applicants will be supportive of the aims, values and ethos of the school and wish to continue their education in a Christian environment. All applicants will meet with a member of staff to discuss possible pathways and ensure they are aiming to follow appropriate courses.

Key dates:

- Closing date for External applications: 27 January 2023
- Date informed of place: March 2023
- Late applications: will be considered where there are a surplus of places in the Sixth Form and in the required courses

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Minimum entry requirements for A Level Programme of Study:

1. **Five** GCSE grades at 5 and above, including English Language or English Literature *plus*
2. **Maths** and **English Language** GCSE at grade **4** or above, *plus*
3. the **subject specific** entry requirements (*shown on the table below*)

Please note that entry criteria for all A Level courses are based on GCSE passes only, not BTEC, OCR or other equivalents

BTEC Level 3 vocational course:

Five GCSE grades at 4 or above (including English Language) or a Merit in a Level 2 BTEC qualification with **Four** GCSE grades at 4 or above (including English Language).

Students who meet the minimum entry requirements for the Sixth Form, but not for their preferred programme of study may be offered more appropriate subject combinations, better matched to their abilities.

Please note that students with an English Language grade 3 or below will not be offered a place in Our Lady's Sixth Form.

We reserve the right to withdraw subjects that are undersubscribed.

Subject specific entry requirements

Health and Social Care	Five GCSE grades at 4 or above (including English Language) or a Merit in Level 2 BTEC Health and Social Care, with Four GCSE grades at 4 or above (including English Language).
Business	Five GCSE grades at 4 or above (including English Language) or a Merit in Level 2 BTEC Business course, with Four GCSE grades 4 or above (including English Language).
IT	Five GCSE grades at 4 or above (including English Language) or a Merit in Level 2 Vocational IT course, with Four GCSE grades at 4 or above (including English Language).
